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Castle Kilbride staff has compiled a list of suggested items for your child to bring with them to Castle Camp

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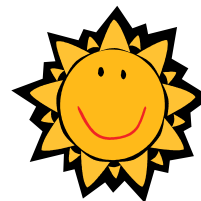
A packed lunch\* and nutritious snack\* (we will be following the Balanced school day with breaks at 10:40 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.)

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## INFORMATION FOR PARENT/GUARDIAN

### Drop-off and Pick-up

Programmes will begin each day at **9:00 a.m.** Parents/Guardians may drop their child off starting at 8:50 a.m. at the **main entrance** of the Castle (near admission desk) where a staff member will be there to greet them. Please sign your child in and let the staff know who will be picking the child(ren) up at the end of the day. We kindly ask that parents do not stay with the group or Programme Leaders during the programme. Along with the Programme Leaders, there may be Castle Kilbride Youth Volunteers assisting and supervising throughout the programme.

The children and the Programme Leaders will be near the Admissions Desk when the programme is over. Children may be picked up no later than **4:00 p.m.** If are going to be late for any reason please call (519) 634-8444 ext.259 immediately. We thank you for your cooperation.

**During the Programme: Food and Snacks:** Castle Kilbride will be following the Balanced School Day routine with 40 minute breaks at 10:40 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. Parents are asked to pack a lunch and a nutritious snack. Please ensure that no nut or main contain traces of nut items are packed as we have students with severe allergic reaction. Please advise the Programme Leaders of any food allergies or sensitivities *prior* to programmes, as some programmes include food preparation and/or handling.

**Summer Camp and Museum Expectations:** Castle Kilbride staff strives to offer an enjoyable and safe experience for all children attending Castle Camp. Programme Leaders will provide children with clear, consistent rules and expectations to create a safe, productive environment where children can play, learn and grow. Please contact Castle Kilbride staff if your child has special needs which could affect their enjoyment and participation in the programme.

**Cancellations from Castle Kilbride:** Should Castle Kilbride cancel programmes because of insufficient registration, a full refund will be issued. Castle Kilbride reserves the right to cancel a programme up to and including five days before said programme.

Some activities advertised as part of any programme may be substituted due to unforeseen circumstances (such as inclement weather), with little or no notice to children or parent/guardian and at the discretion of Castle Kilbride staff.

**Cancellations:** Cancellations received within a minimum of *ten* working days prior to the date booked are subject to a cancellation fee of 20% of the cost. No refunds will be issued for cancellations with less than two weeks notice.
